

PROMOTE knowledge and awareness through campaigns on mitigating environmental disasters




SUPPORT communities to mobilise and organise




ENHANCE solid waste management practices




MAINTAIN and OPTIMIZE infrastructure (such as drainage systems, roads, taps and toilets)
